About The Iron Pour

Each fall, The Steel Yard celebrates its roots in metalwork at the Iron Pour. During the event, foundry artists melt recycled iron in custom-built furnaces that tilt, then pour the glowing metal into molds and over giant themed creations, all made in partnership with the public during Fab Nights. The result is a spectacle of spark and flame that has wowed crowds for 20 years. This year's theme is the firebird, a creature from Slavic myth that symbolizes resurrection and renewal. It's time for feathers and fire!
